Skills We Are Working On:

Self-Help Skills: Taking off coats; putting on coats (flip-flop over top); pouring water; using tongs and/or scooper at snack to self-serve; cleaning up after snack
Social/Emotional: Working together cooperatively; verbalizing feelings and needs; treating others with kindness
Gross Motor: Motor planning; trunk strengthening (criss-cross applesauce)
Fine Motor: Practicing pincer grasp with paintbrushes, playdough, roller paints; Hand-eye coordination
Language: ABC recognition & phonological awareness (initial sounds for beginning of name) Using words to make wants known: "I would like a turn" "I'm using that"; reciting poems; repeating songs; using attribute words
Cognitive: Following two-step directions; participating in movement activities; maintaining focus at table activities; Counting 1-10; number recognition
Making predictions & observations
making choices
